2. Applicant must be an Appraisal Institute Candidate for Designation in good standing pursuing an MAI, SRA, AI-GRS or AI-RRS designation.
3. Applicant must be a member of the Hoosier State Chapter
4. Applicant must have attended two of the applicant's Chapter, Region V or national meetings in the year prior to submitting this application.
5. Applicant must submit a completed application.
6. Applicant must submit a 500 word written essay stating why he or she should be awarded the scholarship highlighting professional goals and experience.
7. Applicant must submit a resume or statement of qualifications.
8. Applicant must submit a list of completed Appraisal Institute courses and designation requirements to date.

Conditions:

- Scholarships may be applied only to the advance courses listed on page 1 and is an Appraisal Institute national offering or any Appraisal Institute chapter or regional offering.
- Scholarship money is for the program fee only.
- No refunds will be given for unused scholarship awards.
- Scholarship money must be used in the same calendar year in which it is awarded.
- This scholarship does NOT apply towards online courses.
